Garden Policies

Our goal is to make our garden a place where its members can grow and enjoy their plots. We wish to make our garden a place of beauty for the community so the following policies will be enforced:

1. Keep your plot and the area around it weed-free, so seeds don't spread to other gardens. Plants need to be kept within the boundary of your plot and paths kept clear for hoses and other gardeners. Plant tall crops only where they will not shade neighboring plots.
2. We encourage only organic products. Do not use fertilizers, insecticides or weed repellants that will in any way affect other plots. If you feel you need to use something non-organic, please check with the team leader of TCC.
3. The fee for the garden plot is due with this signed contract. Do not send in the contract if you have not been contacted that a plot is available. Fees are per growing season, and per plot to help cover garden expenses.
4. When your garden plot is assigned, it must be cultivated or some planting done before May 1. If you plot becomes unkempt, a 1 weeks' notice will be given to clean it up, after that the plot will be reassigned or go back to Tualatin Community Garden.
5. Conserve water when possible by use of watering cans, and spray nozzles. Release the pressure from the hose after turning off the water at the spigot. Do not let water run unattended. Coil hoses at the faucet site after using.
6. Each gardener has a 1 foot box, labeled with their plot number that is for storage of personal items. Other items in the shed are for communal use unless marked otherwise. Use of communal tools must be kept on premises. They should be cleaned and returned to the storage shed after use.
7. Pets must be leashed when in the garden and kept out of other garden plots. Pick up after your pet and do not dispose of pet waste in the compost bin.
8. Do not put anything but dead vegetation, plants and leaves from you plot in the compost bin. Do not dispose of household trash in the Tualatin Community Garden containers.
9. If you must abandon your plot for any reason, please notify the garden team leader from BFCC. You may not transfer your plot to someone else without the permission of the team leader.

I use this garden at the sole discretion of Tualatin Community Garden and Boones Ferry Community Church and agree to abide by its policies and practices. Failure to follow these policies may result in my plot being reassigned.
